GCSE Geography Field Trip

On the morning of Monday 13th May, in bright sunshine and searing heat, a group of year 9 and 10 Geography students left school, complete with plenty of fieldwork equipment to collect data from the River Douglas, on Winter Hill above the picturesque village of Rivington, near Bolton. This data will be used to complete a field-work enquiry, investigating how and why the



river changes, as it flows downstream into Anglezarke Reservoir in Lancashire, to provide water for the city of Liverpool. Whilst by the river (and a lot of the time in it!) the students carried out measurements of the river's width, depth and velocity at six different sites, as well as collecting rock samples from the river to measure for size and shape. All the walking and carrying of equipment, or probably the heat, clearly had an effect on the students as the journey home was very quiet.
