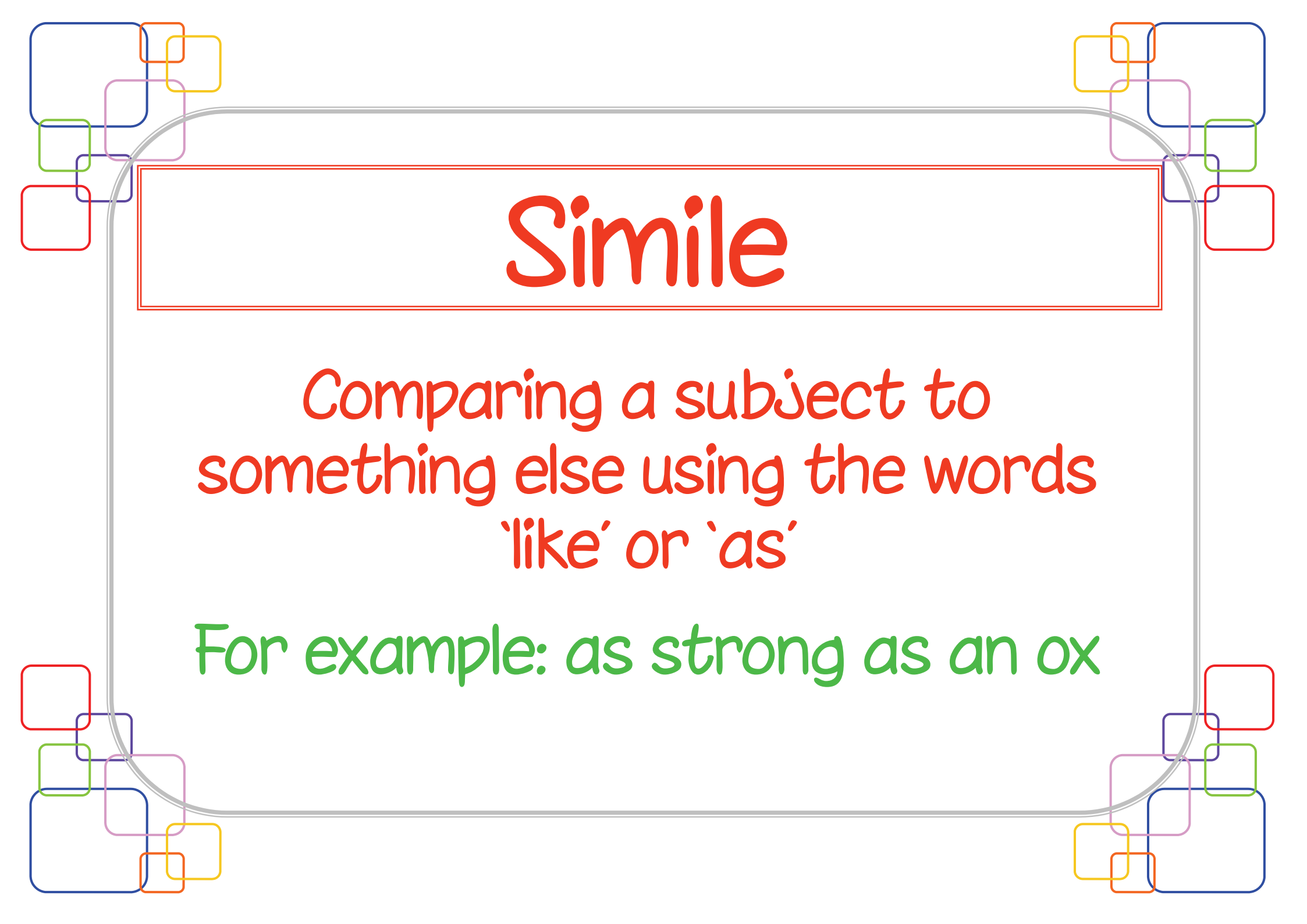




Alliteration

A phrase where words begin with
the same sound.

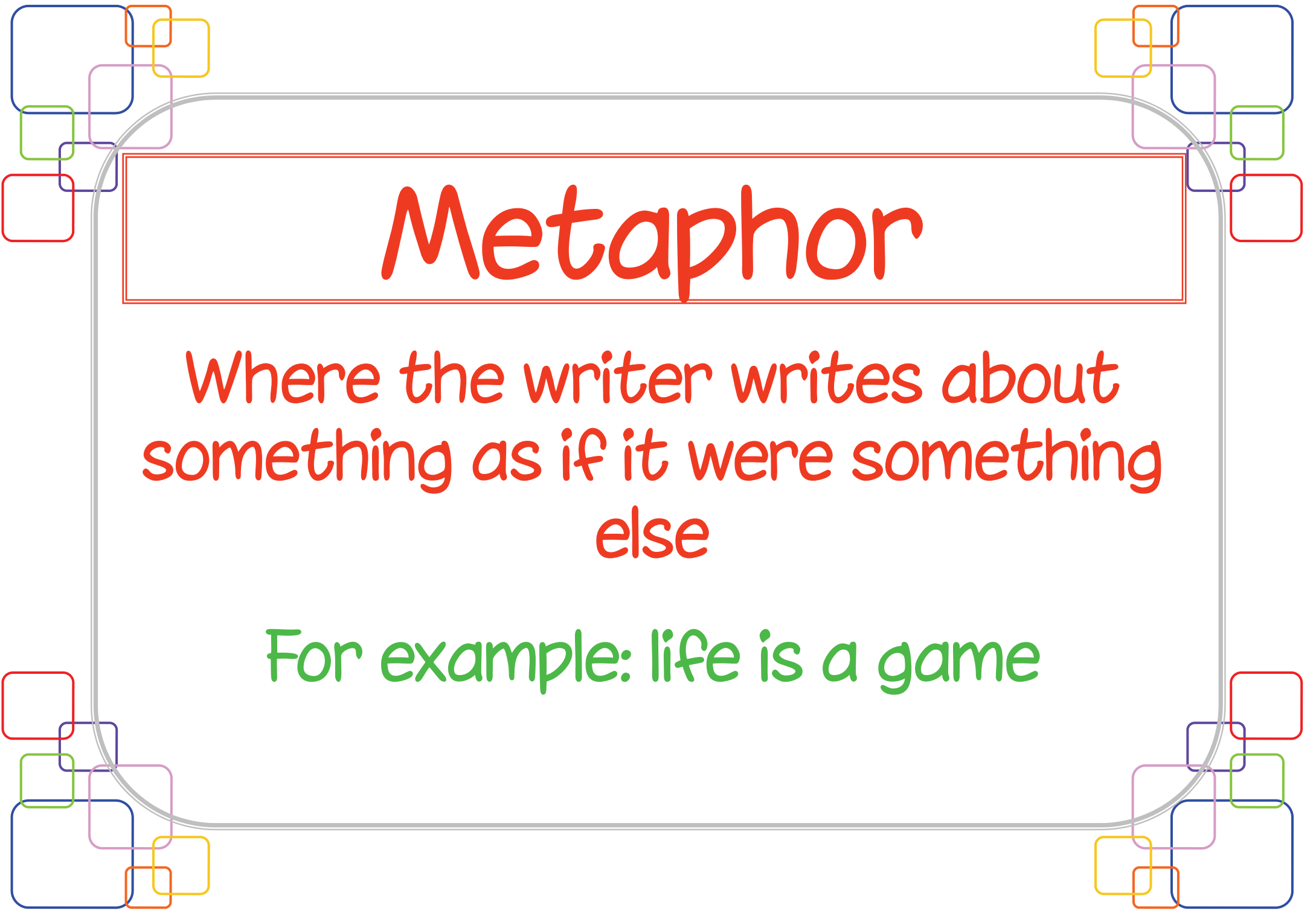
For example: one wet Wellington;
several silent, slithering snakes



Simile

Comparing a subject to
something else using the words
'like' or 'as'

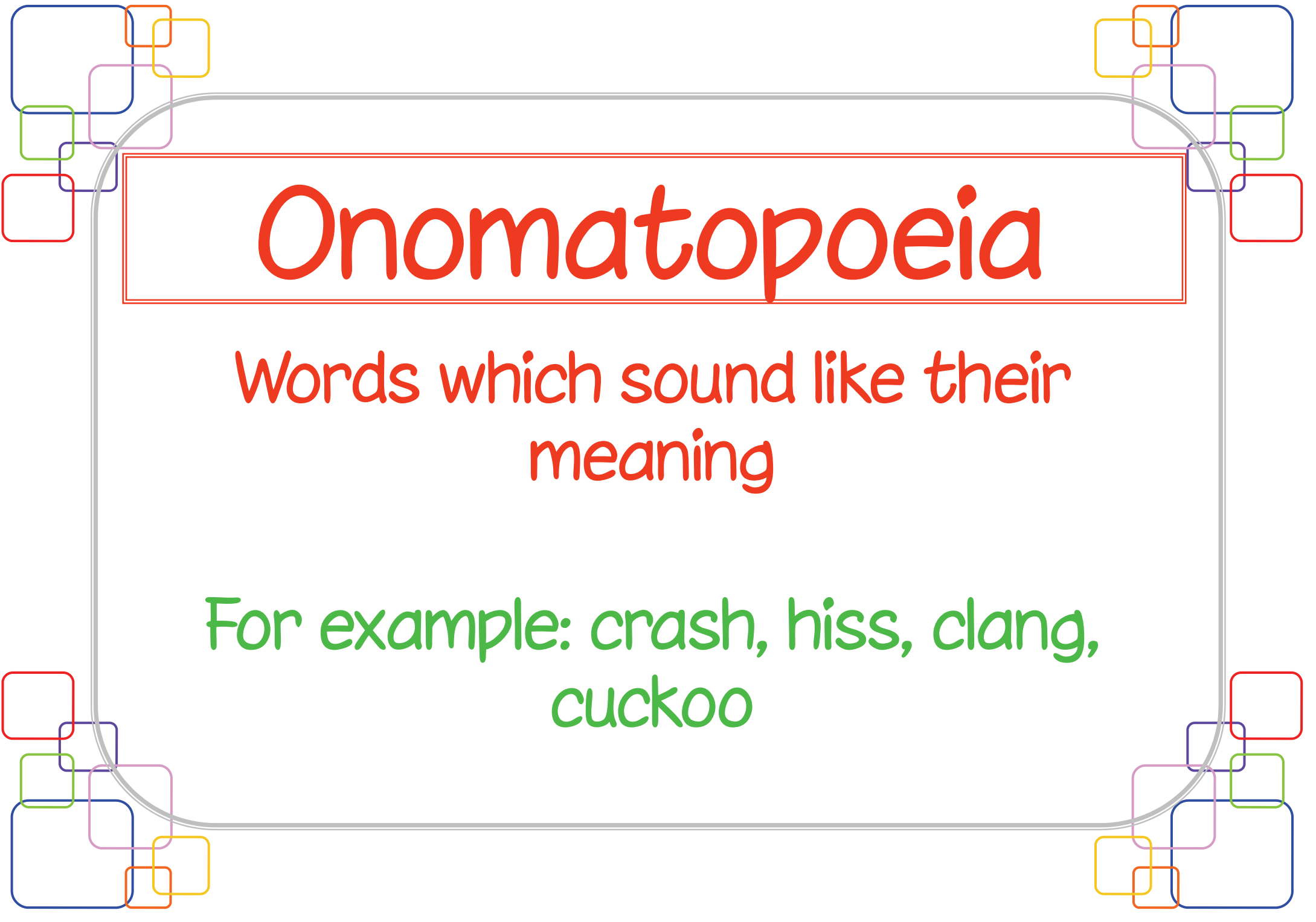
For example: as strong as an ox



Metaphor

Where the writer writes about something as if it were something else

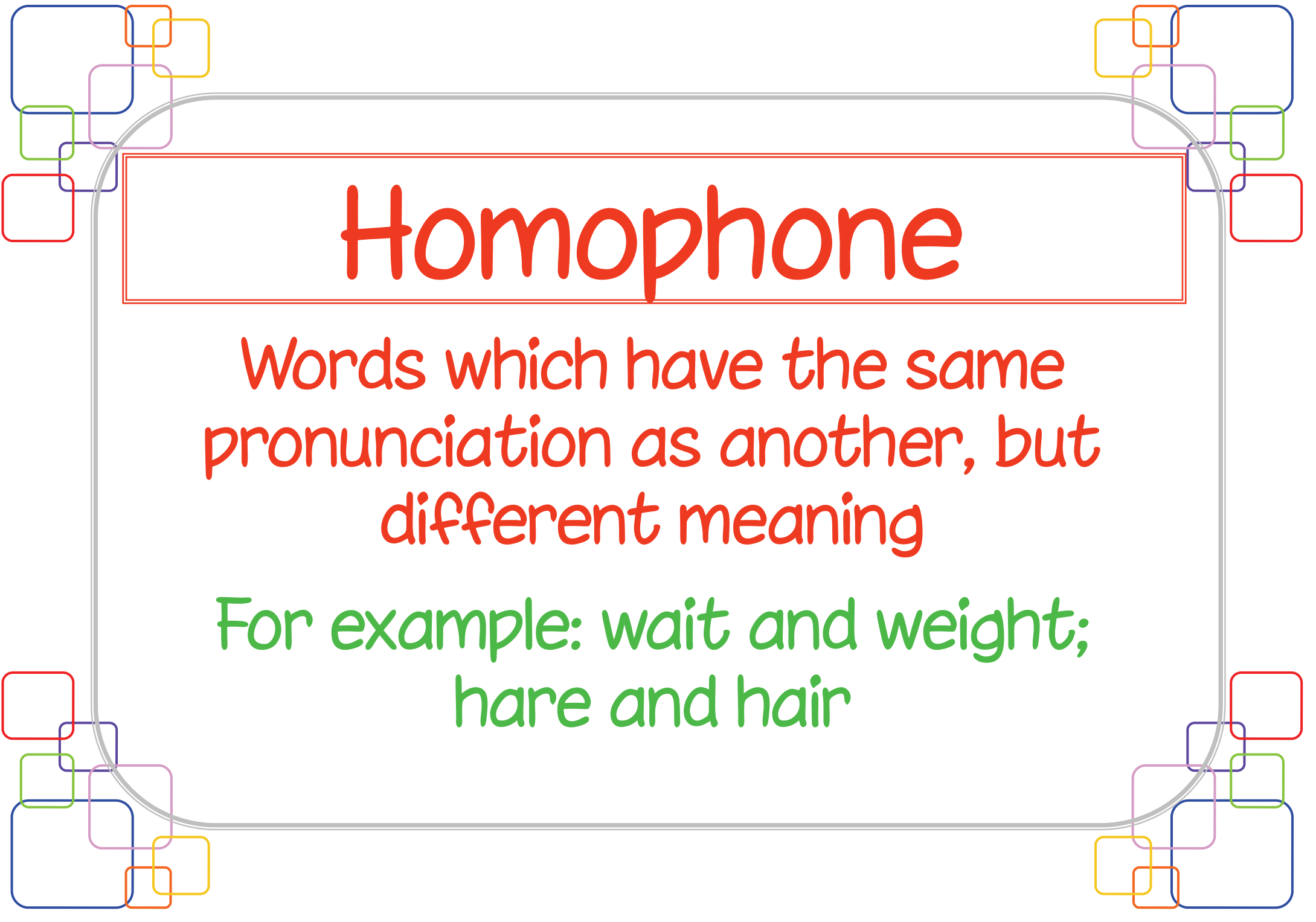
For example: life is a game



Onomatopoeia

Words which sound like their
meaning

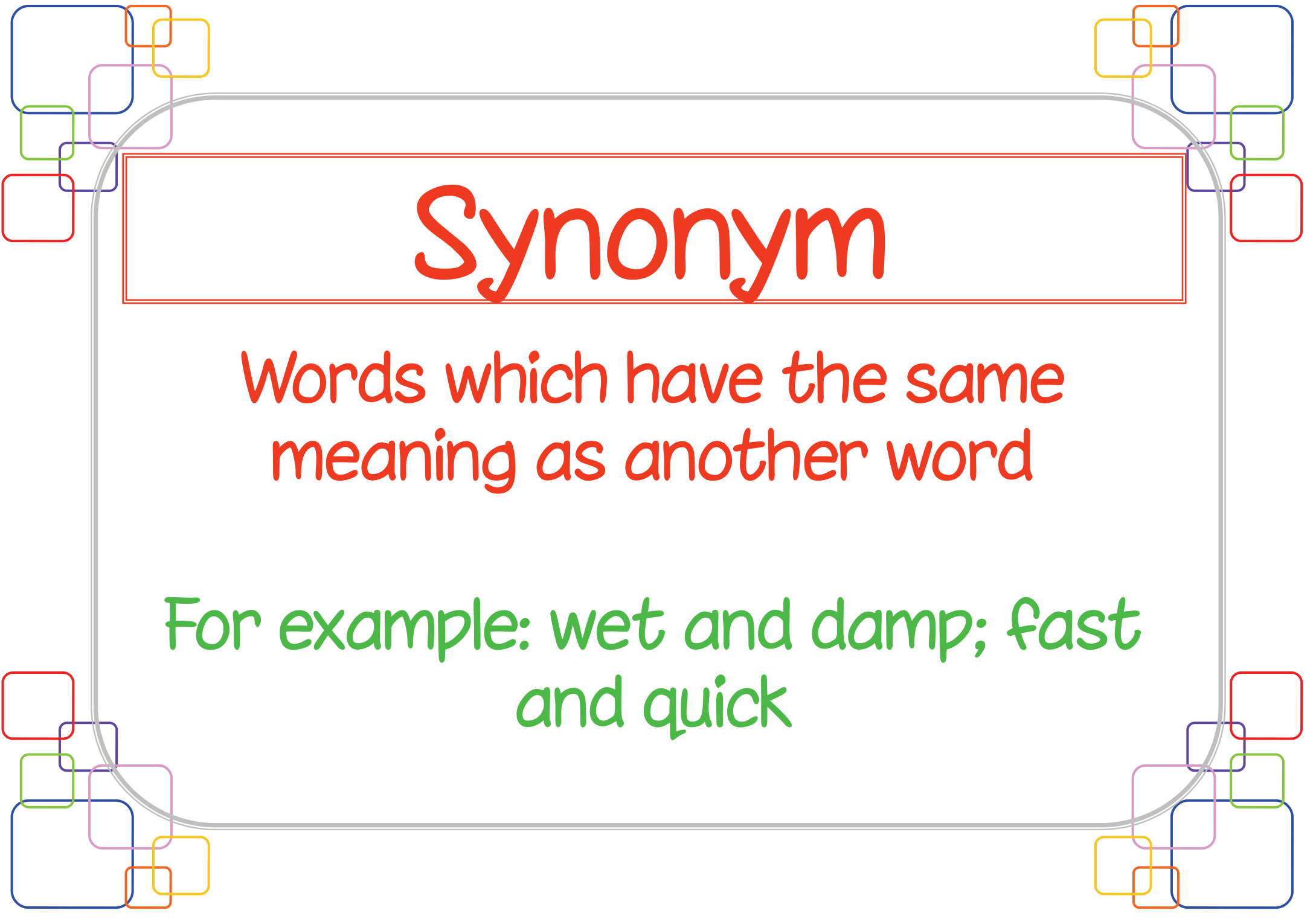
For example: crash, hiss, clang,
cuckoo



Homophone

Words which have the same
pronunciation as another, but
different meaning

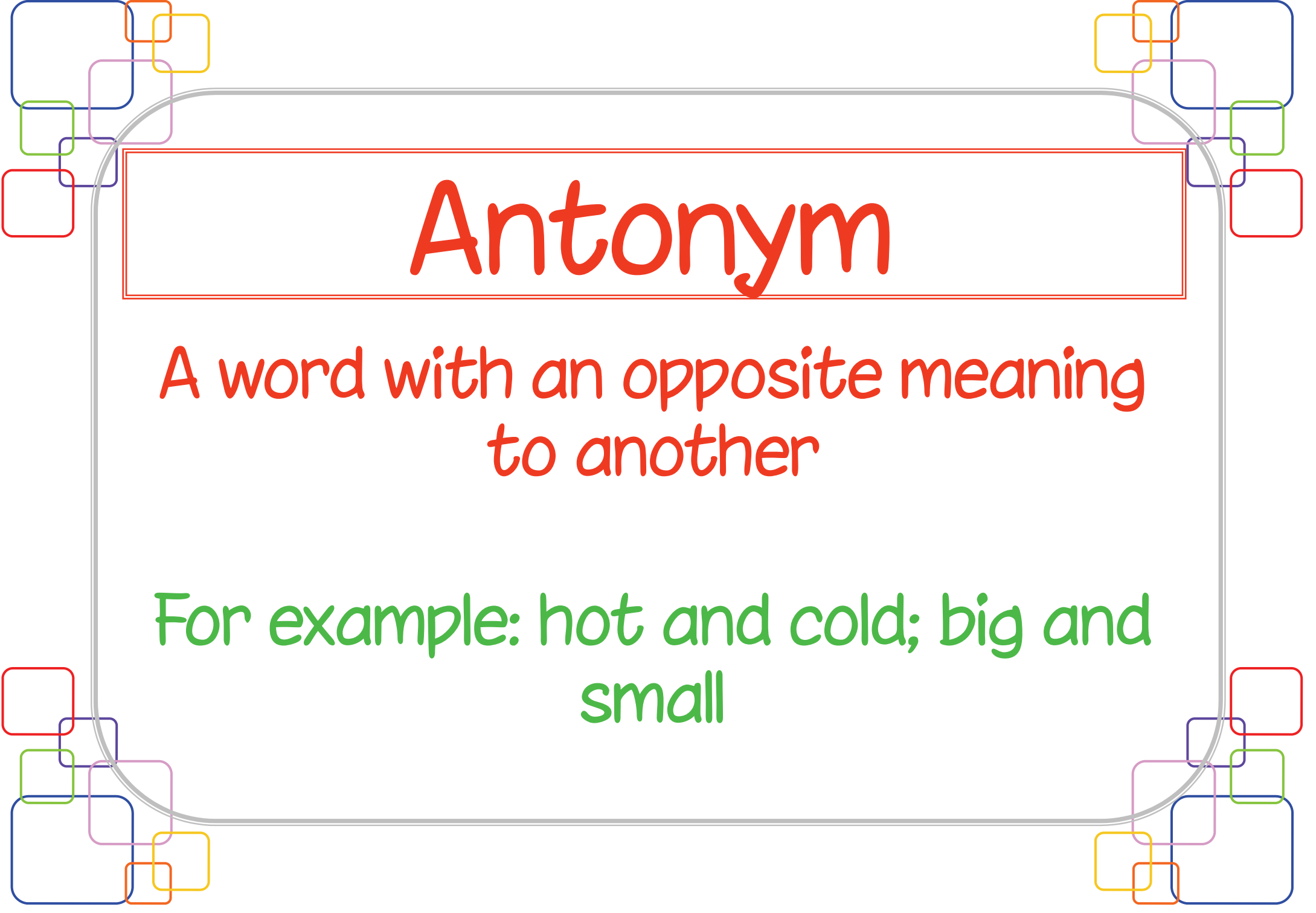
For example: wait and weight;
hare and hair



Synonym

Words which have the same
meaning as another word

For example: wet and damp; fast
and quick



Antonym

A word with an opposite meaning
to another

For example: hot and cold; big and
small
